



Spring cleaning is here. Before you get started, please remember the following:

- Waste Pro does not collect yard waste in plastic bags. All clippings and leaves must be placed in paper bags, biodegradable bags, or trash cans with no more than 50 lbs. in weight. Items not in a container must be no more than 4 feet in length and stacked in bundles weighing less than 50 lbs. Limbs cannot exceed more than 6 inches in diameter. Your county issued trash containers cannot be used for yard waste. If you receive a tag on your yard waste, then the driver determined you did not follow the guidelines and you need to make changes. If you have any questions, please call Waste Pro at 352-366-0352.
- If you have trash that is too large to fit in your garbage can, you **MUST** call Waste Pro at 352-366-0352 and schedule a bulk pickup **BEFORE** you put the items out by the curb. Items should not sit out by the curb for days at a time. They should only be placed by the curb the night before your scheduled pickup.
- Some items may be excluded from curbside pickup. If you call and schedule a pickup and are told that Waste Pro does not pick up the items you have, then you must arrange an alternative pickup method. The closest drop-off location is 10435 Log House Road, Clermont, 34711. The phone number for the drop-off location is 352-394-5137.
- Please do not place your trash cans, yard waste, or bulk items in the street or block pedestrian access. If you place your items in the street, it blocks traffic, keeps debris from entering the storm drains, and makes it hard for the mailman to deliver mail. Please place your items on the county easement or your driveway apron.
